AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing for the purposes of sand extraction and refuse site.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 2ha of native vegetation.
2. The Permit Holder may only clear native vegetation within the area crosshatched yellow on attached Plan 792/1.
3. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by the clearing and use this material for revegetation purposes. The Permit Holder shall take the following measures within the cleared site:
 - (a) Remove all rubbish and artificial debris; and
 - (b) In areas to be revegetated, lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained to an even depth.
4. At least once in each 12 month period for the term of this permit the Permit Holder must remove or kill any weeds growing within areas cleared, revegetated and rehabilitated under this permit.
5. When areas cleared of native vegetation are no longer required, the Permit Holder must revegetate in accordance with the requirements of condition 3 within six months of the date the area is no longer required.
6. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (a) The areas cleared in hectares;
 - (b) The location and co-ordinates where clearing occurred using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994; and
 - (c) The location and co-ordinates of revegetation under condition 3 using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.
7. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the CEO by 31 March setting out the records required under condition 6 of this permit in relation to clearing and revegetation carried out between 1 January and 31 December of the previous year.
