
**FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SELECTIVE LOGGING ON PRIVATE
PROPERTY**

1. Prior to any machinery entering logging area a thorough survey of the intended area to be logged is to take place to identify stream reserves, dieback, protected flora and habitat trees.
2. No logging is to take place in stream reserves – 30 metre buffer on each side of stream.
3. All dieback areas to be delineated and logged separately. Machinery to be cleaned before leaving affected area.
4. No logging on protected flora areas.
5. Trees showing signs of bird nesting to be marked (H) and retained as habitat at least Ten per acre.
6. Only viable trees will be taken leaving seed trees for regeneration at least Ten per acre.
NOTE: The habitat trees and seed trees per acre is a minimum number and after inspection of the logging area these trees left per acre will be double and even triple that.
7. All existing roads to be used as much as possible to reduce impact on vegetation. Loading areas to be made where the least amount of disturbance is needed. All roads and loading areas to be rehabilitated on completion.
8. Where possible, all logs to be dragged across the slopes to reduce soil erosion. All logs to be dragged from bottom of slope to top to reduce the risk of diseases entering streams.
9. No logging to be done on wet weather days.

10. All employees employed by Coalfields Firewood Pty Ltd T/As Malatesta and Sons Sawmill and Firewood to be briefed on this Forest Management Plan. Any breaches will result in termination of employment.
11. All logging areas to be logged must be identified with (Danger Harvesting in Operation) signs.
12. Jason Malatesta, Coalfields Firewood Pty Ltd T/As Malatesta and Sons Sawmill and Firewood has had over 20yrs experience in the forest logging industry including several years of working for the forest products commission in native forest logging and is aware of all requirements.
13. Any fuel or oil spills to be confined and effected soil removed.
14. Visual inspection of every tree to identify any hollows over 4 inch diameter to be left for cockatoo nesting.
15. Limited activity in the Carnaby cockatoo breeding season (July-September)
16. All areas to be logged have sheep grazing for the past 80yrs. There is next to no ground cover in these areas. The owner Erik is an avid plant lover and would not allow me access to any areas with rare native Fauna.






