A DESCRIPTION OF A SECRETARY OF A SE	Hastings has a clearing permit (CPS 8050/1) that includes a road (8050 Photo Map). However, during detailed engineering the alignment of the road has changed slightly (Figure 1). The revised road alignment has a more favourable environmental outcome as it intersects narrower sections of the drainage crossings. The realignment of the road has changed the location of the clearing footprint but has not resulted in increasing the proposed clearance area.
