The clearing is required to facilitate the construction of a dual use path from the Augusta Boat Harbour to Dead Finish Rd. The pathway will be constructed to approximately a 2m wide hardened surface and will require a maximum clearing width of 4m to facilitate truck and machinery access. The detailed design is currently underway, as such a corridor 10m wide has been identified within which the trail will be constructed. A flora and fauna survey has been undertaken to facilitate the project. Vegetation condition ranges from degraded through to very good and evidence of threatened fauna has been found in the project area. The proposed alignment has been modified to reflect recommendations in the flora fauna report to minimise impact upon the Low Closed Forest of Agonis Flexuosa and associated Western Ringtail Possum habitat. Construction of a pathway adjacent to Leeuwin Road has been extensively investigated

however road safety requirements would result in an offset from the road and as such would result in minimal reduction in clearing compared to the proposed alignment. Furthermore, in
