



CLEARING PERMIT

Granted under section 51E of the Environmental Protection Act 1986

The Permit Holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

PART I – CLEARING AUTHORISED

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purpose of constructing a hardstand area.

2. Land on which clearing is to be done

Lot 329 on Deposited Plan 218632 (Crown Reserve 43754), Kwinana Beach
Lot 2580 on Plan 12662 (Crown Reserve 36149), Kwinana Beach
Patterson Road reserve (PIN 1193212), Kwinana Beach
Mandurah Road reserve (PIN 11959184), Kwinana Beach

3. Area of Clearing

The Permit Holder must not clear more than 1.77 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 8425/1.

4. Application

This Permit allows the Permit Holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the Permit Holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

PART II – MANAGEMENT CONDITIONS

5. Avoid, minimise and reduce the impacts and extent of clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

6. Erosion control

Construction of the hardstand area must occur within two months of cessation of clearing authorised under this Permit.

PART III - RECORD KEEPING AND REPORTING

7. Records to be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, in relation to the clearing of native vegetation authorised under this permit:

- (a) the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit set to Geocentric Datum Australia 1994 (GDA94), expressing the geographical coordinates in Eastings and Northings or decimal degrees;
- (b) the date that the area was cleared;
- (c) the size of the area cleared (in hectares);
- (d) the date clearing activities ceased;
- (e) the date that construction of the hardstand area began; and
- (f) actions taken to avoid, minimise and reduce the impacts and the extent of clearing in accordance with condition 5 of this Permit.

8. Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the *CEO* the records required under Condition 7 of this Permit, when requested by the *CEO*.

DEFINITIONS

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

CEO means the Chief Executive Officer of the Department responsible for the administration of the clearing provisions under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*;
