The City of Rockingham has received a request to provide a suitable lot space to support the rigging and overnight storage of approximately 80-100 catamarans to accommodate large events such as those held by the Cruising Yacht Club of WA on the Rockingham foreshore. The current turfed and rigging areas available to the yacht club are congested during large events.
