#### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**




Figure 1: Map of the boundary of the area within which clearing may occur

The permit holder must not clear more than 14 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow in Figure 1 of Schedule 1.

#### CONDITIONS.

# 1. Avoid, minimise, and reduce impacts and extent of clearing

In determining the native vegetation authorised to be cleared under this permit, the permit holder must apply the following principles, set out in descending order of preference:

- (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

## 2. Staged clearing

The Permit Holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively commencing horticultural activities within three months of the authorised clearing being undertaken.

## 3. Records that must be kept

The permit holder must maintain records relating to the listed relevant matters in accordance with the specifications detailed in Table 1.

The boundary of the area authorised to be cleared is shown in the map below (Figure 1).
