The application relates to the Ocean Reef Marina Development (Development) that is located to the west of Ocean Reef Road, Ocean Reef, Western Australia. The terrestrial Development comprises an area of 42 ha. The Development area was removed from Bush Forever Site 325 by the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS) amendment 1270/41 (August 2019).

Specifically, an area of 6.35 ha is to be cleared within a clearing area footprint of 7.38 ha to support the Early Works program.
