

# Application to amend a clearing permit

Environmental Protection Act 1986, section 51KA

#### FORM C4

The clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia unless a clearing permit has been granted for the clearing or where a permit is not required (either due to a referral determination that one is not needed or because an exemption applies). A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

This is due to the postponement of the works at the southern section of road (SLK 1 – 1.7) due the need to resolve to a land title issue (land title issue is not relevant to the proposed clearing, but is relevant to the broader road reconstruction project). Two years should provide adequate time to resolve this issue and reschedule the proposed works.</li> <li>Remove the northern clearing at SLK 3.45 from the permit (7 trees). The road works in this section has been completed and all trees were able to be retained. The amended permit will therefore be for the remaining 8 trees in the southern clearing area at SLK 1 – 1.7 – which were in the original permit.</li> </ol>
