The proposed Railway Parade Shared Path and parking re-alignment in Beckenham has been designed in close consultation with the Public Transport Authority to retain as many trees as possible. The proposed shared path underwent several re-designs to ensure tree retention was maximised. Two sections of the path are proposed to be elevated to ensure the retention of large, iconic trees. A section of the path near Beckenham Station is proposed to be constructed of concrete to minimise disturbance to the significant trees. Where the path is proposed close to trees, the width has been minimised as much as practicable.
