A proposal was put forward for the construction of 20 parking bays along Capricorn Esplanade.  Additionally, the provision of additional car parking bays will assist in alleviating the concerns of future tenants of the Yanchep Surf Club facility regarding adequate parking to support sustainable operations.  No other sites within the area were found to be suitable for the construction of car parking bays.
