Environmental Protection Act 1986, section 51KA

The clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia unless a clearing permit has been granted for the clearing or where a permit is not required (either due to a referral determination that one is not needed or because an exemption applies). A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

This will necessitate additional mining areas and increase in associated infrastructure footprints.</p> <p>An additional Targeted Flora Survey has been undertaken to better understand the abundance and locations of Priority flora in the Project and surrounding areas and provide justification for additional clearing of individual plants.</p> <p>This NCVF Amendment seeks approval for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An increase in clearing by 355.7 ha (from 265 ha to 620.7 ha). Removal of two of the four areas currently 'subject to conditions' within the approved clearing area of M52/1074 as depicted in Plan 8991/2 and stated in Condition 5 of Clearing Permit CPS 8991/2. These are located in the western part of the Purpose Permit Area and have an area of 2.81 and 16.83 ha respectively. <p>An assessment against the ten clearing principles was undertaken based on information collected from site-specific flora, fauna surveys of the project area.</p> <p>The assessment of the proposed clearing against the ten clearing principles determined that the proposed additional clearing, including clearing within 'areas subject to conditions' for the Butcherbird Project expansion will not be at variance with the ten clearing principles. Appropriate environmental management procedures will be implemented to ensure potential impacts associated with the clearing are avoided or minimised where practicable.</p>
