In order to improve the safety of this section of road, it is necessary to widen the road to allow two vehicles to pass safely. The road is frequented by large trucks and machinery to support surrounding agricultural land uses, and the road at its current width does not provide for the safe passage of vehicles.								
	Widening the road will result in the clearing of up to 2 metres of roadside vegetation on either side of the road.								
	A desktop assessment, followed by a site inspection by environment and landcare officers has been undertaken of the clearing area, and a report with photos is provided at Attachment 1.								
	Given the small amount of clearing (0.39 ha), and the degraded condition of the native vegetation, it is not considered that the proposed clearing of 0.39 ha along an 800 metre section of Rosa Glen Road will be at variance with the native vegetation clearing principles.								
	The following mitigation strategies will be implemented by the Shire of Augusta Margaret River to minimise impacts of the proposed clearing.								
	<ul> <li>Clearing of native vegetation will be minimised wherever possible. The road widening has been designed to avoid any unnecessary disturbance to vegetation, particularly large habitat trees.</li> <li>Retrenchment pruning of large branches will be undertaken as an alternative to tree removal where branches pose a safety hazard.</li> <li>There will be no changes to existing surface drainage patterns.</li> <li>Dieback and weed hygiene measures will be implemented during operations.</li> </ul>
