Clearing has been kept to the minimum required for the project. Clearing of the pit area is unavoidable, but the access corridor has been located along a previously cleared track/firebreak to avoid clearing of native vegetation. Only 1.7 ha of native vegetation in good condition is to be cleared. The remainder of the permit area is degraded (0.8 ha) or completely degraded (7.5 ha of pine plantation).
