Avoidance measures taken include locating the development within an area that has been previously cleared of native vegetation, ensuring no clearing of the conservation significant vegetation in the north-eastern and south-eastern portions of the application area. In addition, the majority of the black cockatoo habitat trees will be retained, in addition to the majority of the black cockatoo foraging habitat within the application area.  Other mitigation measures that will be incorporated as part of the proposed clearing include the salvage and transplanting of vegetation from the application area for use in the broader area, and revegetation of the landscaped public open space areas with native plant species. |  |  |  |  |
