of, the proposed clearing of native vegetation.	The road upgrade corridor was reduced from 22 m wide to 20 m wide and this reduced the total clearing required by 2.58 ha – from 7.28 ha to 5.25 ha. Not clearing a section of road corridor where the densest patch of Melaleuca tall shrubland vegetation occurs reduced proposed clearing by another 0.48 ha to 4.77 ha. By not removing five <i>Eucalyptus rudis</i> trees with a DBH ≥ 50 cm that occur within the upgrade corridor, impact to Carnaby's Cockatoo potential breeding habitat trees has been reduced to zero. Not pruning the higher canopy of trees in this area has reduced clearing by another 0.19 ha to 4.58 ha.										
	The Shire has reduced overall clearing originally proposed by 2.70 ha, which is a reduction of 37%.										
	Reducing the corridor width and not clearing in one of the wetland sections has reduced impact to Carnaby's Cockatoo foraging habitat from an original 5.31 ha to 3.58 ha (i.e. by 32.53%). Reducing the clearing width and not removing any trees or pruning branches from the higher canopy of trees in the <i>Eucalyptus rudis</i> vegetation type has reduced impact to										
	Carnaby's Cockatoo potential breeding and roosting habitat from an original 0.24 ha to zero. Reducing the corridor width has reduced impact to the two Banksia woodland / forest vegetation types mapped in the corridor by 1.53 ha (from an initial 5.23 ha to 3.71 ha). Not clearing in one of the wetland areas has reduced clearing of Banksia woodland by another 0.18 ha to 3.53 ha. Therefore, clearing of these two vegetation types has been reduced by 32.51%.							est ha). d by
