Black Cat took ownership of tenements M25/350, M26/248, M26/364, M26/417 in July 2020. Tenement registration is yet to be transferred to Black Cat's name. A Letter of Authority confirming Black Cat's ownership is included with this submission.

Tenements L25/23, L25/37, L25/49 belong to Silver Lake (Integra) Pty Ltd. A Letter of Consent approving Black Cat's use of these tenements is included with this submission. Note that Black Cat does not intend to clear native vegetation on these tenements. However the area that is already cleared is captured within the disturbance envelope detailed in this submission.
