

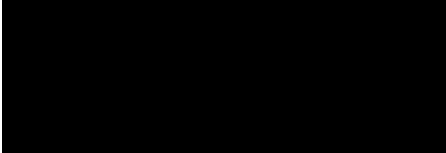

CLEARING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR PROPOSED TEMPORARY ACCESS TO FOLEY VILLAGE NEW AGED CARE FACILITY ON STOCK ROAD, HILTON

I refer to your correspondence with Main Roads on 25 November 2020 requesting approval to apply to the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) for clearing of vegetation to allow temporary access to Foley Village New Aged Care Facility on Stock Road in Hilton, in accordance with drawings and other information provided to Main Roads to date. Main Roads provides approval to Southern Cross Care (WA) Inc. to apply for a DWER permit for this proposal subject to the following conditions:

- Main Roads shall be provided with a copy of any permit received from the DWER, with associated drawings and conditions, prior to any works commencing.
- Southern Cross Care (WA) Inc. will be completely and soely responsible for the compliance and reporting requirements of any permits obtained for the proposed works within Main Roads land. This includes revegetating the area cleared in accordance with the following Main Roads requirements (previously stipulated in email to proponent dated 16 October 2020):
 - Planting of tube stock representative of vegetation removed (includes *Eucalyptus* sp.).
 - Temporary storage and replanting of existing grass trees once temporary access is no longer required.
- Access to the Main Roads land is only permitted with a valid Roadway Access Authorisation obtained in accordance with the guidelines and forms available at <https://www.mainroads.wa.gov.au/technical-commercial/working-on-roads>.
