Condition 10a and 10c of Native Vegetation Clearing Permit CPS 9203/1 requires an annual report to be submitted by 31 July 2022. To date, there has been no clearing conducted under CPS 9203/1.

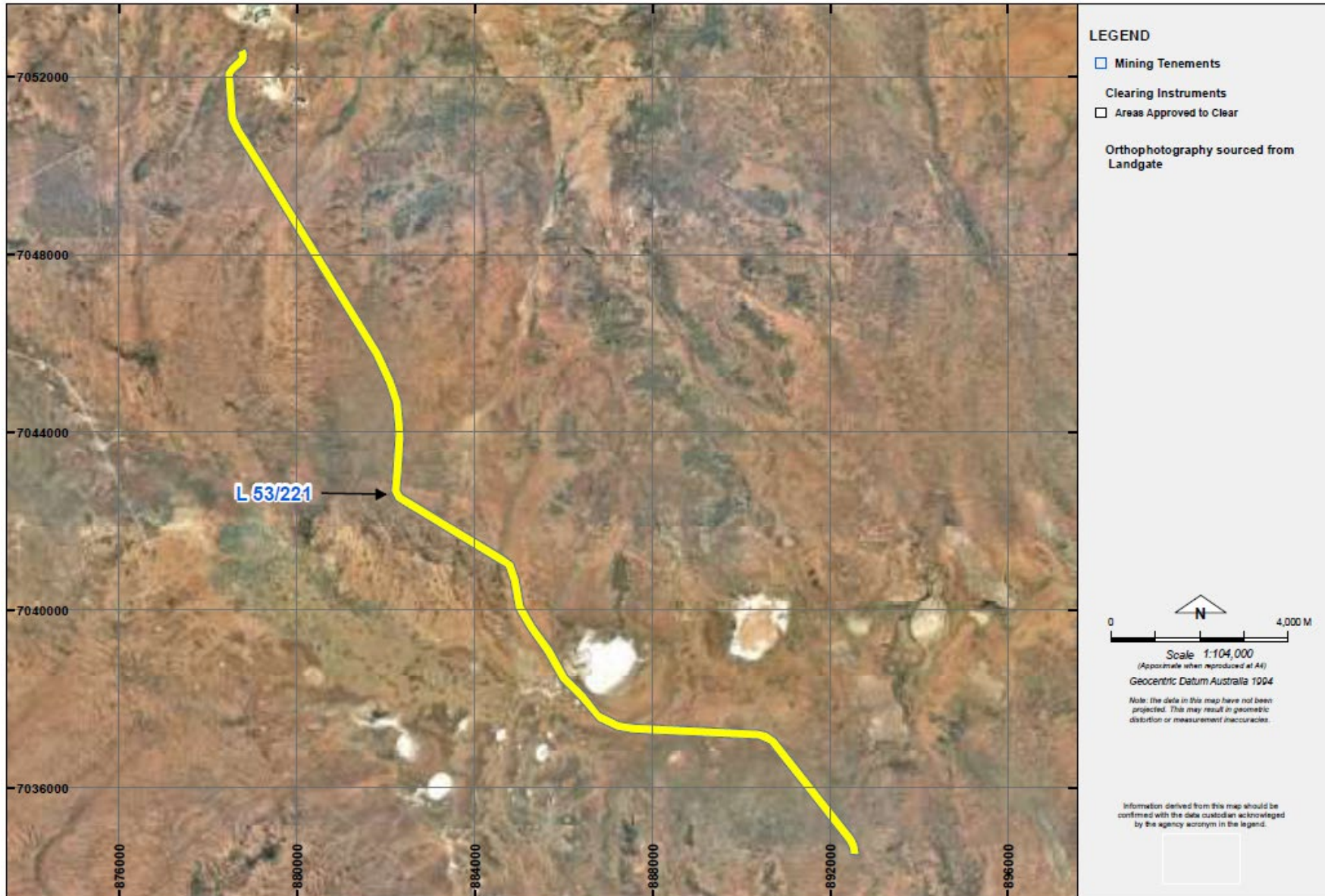

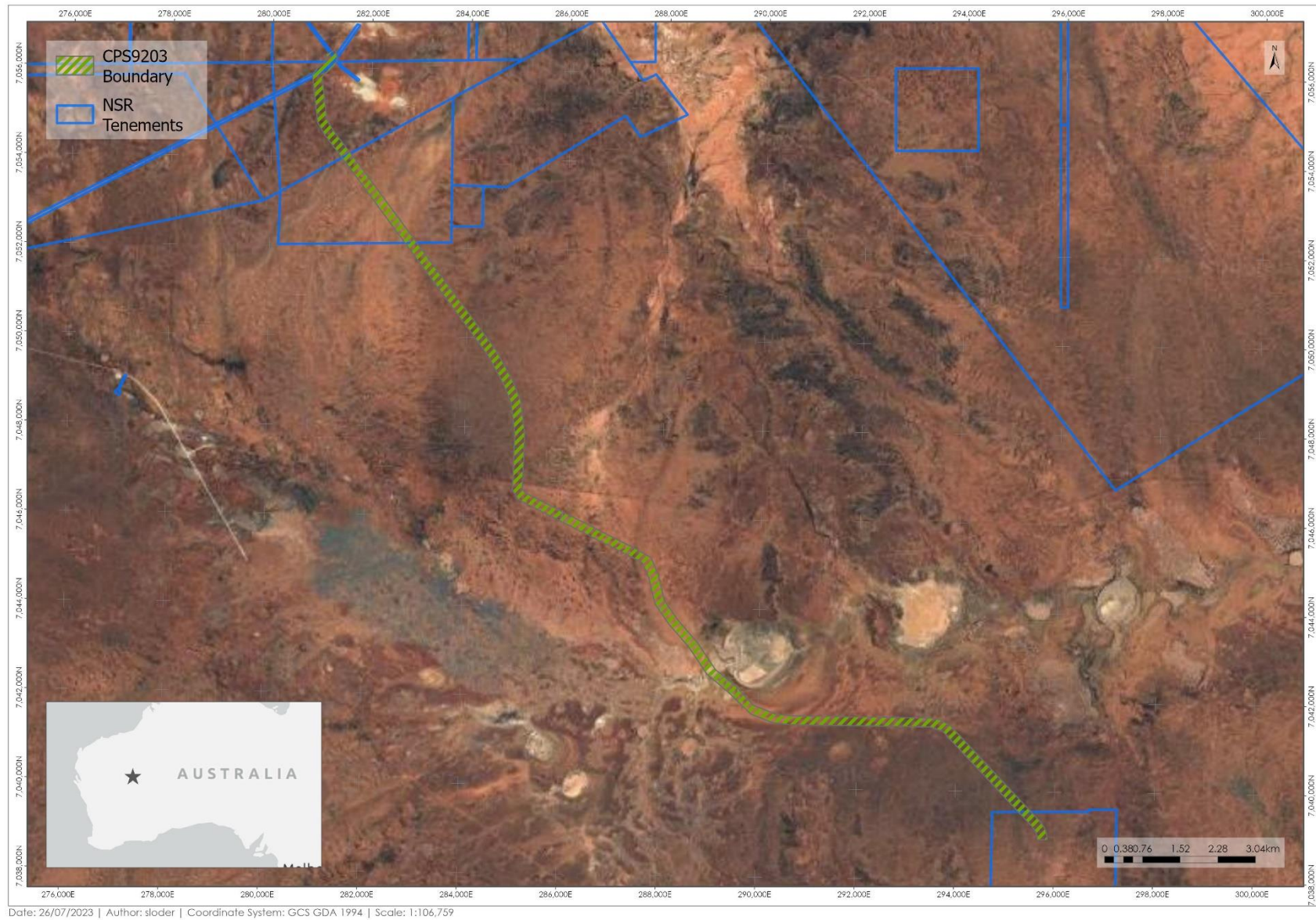
