Title: **Photopoint locations – Cuballing East Road**
(File names: Cuballing East LHS Photopoint locations_points.shp & Cuballing East RHS Photopoint locations_points.shp)

Custodian: Shire of Cuballing

Jurisdiction: Western Australia

Description: This dataset consists of two sets of shape files, showing the location of photopoints of trees marked for removal to facilitate road improvements. Photo point locations were collected using a mobile phone camera and a hand held GPS, with the data collector taking photos from the road (not next to each tree). Some photo points represent a single tree and some represent multiple trees. This dataset records the number of trees by tree species and identifies its location with reference to SLK sections of the Cuballing East Road. A separate dataset was created for each side of the road.

Spatial Coverage: Cuballing East Road (between SLK 4 and SLK 18), Shire of Cuballing

Descroptio - SLK point location as recorded in the field at the time of the photo being taken

Comments - record of number of trees and tree species picture if more than one tree is covered by a single photopoint
