Provide the avoidance and mitigation details	The Proposal area has been reduced from 35 ha to 15.7 ha to minimise the environmental impacts associated with vegetation clearing. Efficiencies have been achieved in the layout of new infrastructure by providing a compact arrangement that minimises wasted space and vegetation pockets. The Proposal area has also been redesigned to reduce impacts to five Priority 3 flora species recorded within the Proposal Area.
