

CPS 9574/1 - Supporting information – Proposal particulars and history of property

Proposal

Due to health and age we are planning on remaining on the property in a smaller building and are proposing to build an ancillary building to accommodate us. Whilst we are requesting to clear 6 banksia trees, we have several of these in the remaining bush area. We have avoided removing any jarrah trees, as we do not have many of these on the property. We will be continuing our planting programme with our Daughter and Son in law, both Horticulturists and who have been assisting us in our programme.

History of Property

When we acquired the property December 1999 it had previously been mostly cleared and revegetation was mostly re growth woolly bush. We were and are very conscious of preserving as many as practical of the remaining or regrowth native trees. Over time we have replaced the dead woolly bush with native trees and shrubs. This is still an ongoing project.

We have no intention of having livestock on this property. (Our neighbouring properties have several horses in residence)
