5.6 Avoidance and Mitigation

We propose to use the Xanthorrhoea as a decorative feature at the gates of a different property occupied by Drainflow Services Pty Ltd (Crocker Dr, Malaga) in the City of Swan to showcase native flora as an ode to the business' ties to Western Australia.

With that in mind, we selected the proposed clearing location of 414 Douglas Rd Beermullah as this property is also owned by Drainflow Services Pty Ltd. The Xanthorrhoea will be a symbolic tie between properties to showcase the link between our composting facility (Douglas Rd, Beermullah) and our waste management facility (Crocker Dr, Malaga) where these trees will be planted.

We have also selected the Xanthorrhoea as they are a strong plant that can withstand the Western Australian heat and requires minimal water to survive. Our commitment to water conservation is of the upmost importance to Drainflow Services and is another way in which we can demonstrate our business' environmental sustainability. This plant will allow us to continue to minimize our water usage.

Although we are proposing to clear native vegetation as a business Drainflow Services is committed to protecting the native fauna and flora at our properties and site locations.
