The clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia unless a clearing permi has been granted for the clearing or where a permit is not required (either due to a referral determination that one is not needed or because an exemption applies). A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

| | The additional areas are required to undertake directional drilling and excavation for installation of low-voltage supply points connecting to and from the required distribut pillars and pole top transformers. Additional clearing of vegetation is required to maintain direct line-of-sight between the next immediate installing street poles. Without these works, the streetlights will not be able to operate and the presence of vegetation between adjacent poles will create visibility and sightline issues. Overall, minimal clearing will be undertaken and clearing will be limited to what is required for works.
