Purpose of proposed clearing:	The proposed clearing is intended to remove native vegetation that has re-grown on previously disturbed areas and earthen features, such as windrows, levees, and road verges which is required to commence mining within Gypsum Mining Block 23.

Locality:	Shire of Carnarvon
Clearing size:	9 hectares
Expiration date:	14 October 2027

## Referral determination

The Department of Mines, Petroleum and Exploration has considered the above referral and determined under section 51DA(3) of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 (the EP Act) that a clearing permit is not required for the proposed clearing of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched pink on the attached map detailed in Schedule 1.
