Purpose of proposed clearing:	Construction of a housing project
Location of proposed clearing:	Lot 297 on Deposited Plan 93256
Locality:	Dampier Peninsula
Clearing size:	4.95 hectares of native vegetation

Referral determination:

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation has considered the above referral and determined under section 51DA(3) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (the EP Act) that a clearing permit **is required** for the proposed clearing of the area cross-hatched orange on the attached map detailed in Schedule 1 (the referral area).

The reason for this determination is that the proposed clearing does not satisfy all of the criteria specified in s.51DA(4) of the EP Act. Specifically:

- there are known or likely significant environmental values identified within the referral area
- there are issues that would arise as a result of the proposed clearing that are likely to require conditions to manage or mitigate effects on the environment.
